The course will give them the qualifications and skills to work as stewards until they are able to get their professional security qualifications (such as the Door Supervisor Award or the CCTV Award). £0 DURATION 2 WEEKS LOCATION JOBSMART

A risk assessment will be carried out to check if the person would be suitable to attend at the centre - contact with probation services will be made, as needed. Qualifications gained will include HABC Award in Conflict Management Level 2, NCFE Award in Understanding Stewarding at Spectator Events, NCFE Certificate in Equality and Diversity Level 2 and HABC Emergency First Aid at Work Level 3. A guaranteed interview with a stewarding company is included.
