HOW TO APPLY AND PAY

After you have applied and been offered a place on a course, you will receive a link, ID and password by email to apply for your bus pass online through our online payment portal, WisePay.

You can pay for the College bus service in full or in three instalments. This must be paid in full by 31 October.

Financial support may be available to assist with the costs of transport if your household income is below £35,000 per year. Once you have been offered a place on a course, you will receive more information on how to apply for financial support.

Bus passes are printed onto your College ID badge. You must go to Reception to collect your bus pass as soon as you have made your first payment or received confirmation of bursary support for transport. Students will not be able to travel on College buses without a valid bus pass.



FAQs

My parents live on 2 different bus routes, do I need to purchase two bus passes?

Each situation is assessed on an individual basis, please contact the Transport teams for more information.

Can I receive a temporary bus pass for one-time use?

Single trip temporary bus passes may be available. Each situation is assessed on an individual basis, please contact the Transport teams for more information.

Can I pay in instalments?

Yes. By selecting the 'pay by instalment' option in WisePay you will have the option to pay 3 instalments of £250. The full balance is due by 31 October. **Instalments are not termly payments for College transport.**

Can students park on campus if they have a car?

All cars parked on campus need a parking pass which are available from Reception. If students pass their driving tests during the year and have already used College transport, the full balance is still owed. Refunds will only be processed before 1 November. Once you have received a refund you will need to surrender your bus pass. See our Transport Terms and Conditions for details.

Am I entitled to a refund if I leave before completing my course?

No. By applying and paying for a bus pass, you are signing up for a full academic year and therefore you are not entitled to a refund as the full amount has been incurred by the College.

Can I travel without a bus pass if I'm a student at College?

No. All students travelling on College contract buses must have a valid bus pass for the current academic year.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please visit our websites for full terms and conditions.

By applying and paying for a bus pass, you are signing up for a full academic year; if there are changes to your circumstances and you wish to cease using home to College transport after 31 October 2025, you will not be entitled to a refund for any amounts paid up to that point and are committing to pay the full cost of a bus pass for the academic year.

If you wish to cease using home to College transport before 31 October 2025, for any reason, you will be entitled to a refund, pro rata from the first day of the academic year. Students must inform the Information Services team and surrender their bus pass before a refund can be issued. All refund enquiries should be made in writing to the Information Services team, via email. Requests will be acknowledged and processed within 10 working days in line with IEG refund policy.

If you choose to pay for the bus pass in instalments, once the first instalment has been paid you are signing up for transport for the entire year and will be expected to pay the full balance by 31 October 2025.

Your College bus pass will be printed onto your ID badge and will only be issued upon receipt of the first instalment, full payment, or the approval of a financial support application. Bus passes can be printed at Reception or during enrolment and it is the responsibility of students to collect.

If you do not have a bus pass, or forget your bus pass, you will be refused travel.

Whilst waiting for your bus, on board the College bus, and waiting in the bus lanes, you are subject to the Student Code of Conduct.

Students found to be in breach of these rules will be subject to the College's disciplinary procedure and may have their bus pass removed and be instructed to find alternative transport to College:

- Do not attempt to open the doors of the bus.
- Do not try to embark or disembark the bus whilst it is moving, wait until the bus has come to a complete stop.
- Do not loan your bus pass to anyone else. Fraudulent bus pass use will result in disciplinary action and a travel ban.
- Remain in your seat whilst the bus is moving and wear seatbelts where provided.
- Do not obstruct the drivers view or distract the drivers in any way.
- Do not eat or drink on board the buses.
- Swearing, verbal aggression, bullying or fighting are not tolerated on any College bus route. Such behaviours will lead to the College disciplinary procedures being invoked and a travel ban issued.

- Alcohol, smoking, vaping, possession or use of illegal substances are strictly prohibited on all bus routes. Such behaviours will lead to the College disciplinary procedures being invoked and a travel ban issued.
- Do not damage, graffiti or vandalise the bus in any way. Such behaviours will lead to the College disciplinary procedures being invoked and you will also be liable to pay for any damage caused to the property of the bus company.
- Do not leave litter on the bus - there are bins located next to the bus lane.

We advise you arrive at your bus stop 10 minutes before departure time.
